

Methodology

- Assumed Fixed Location (i.e. Opponents Bar)
- Plot Desired Matchups vs.Potential Opposition
- Caveats
 - Game restrictions
 - Ignoring random factor
 - Ignoring strategy
 - Assuming no one has identical winning % (gender)
