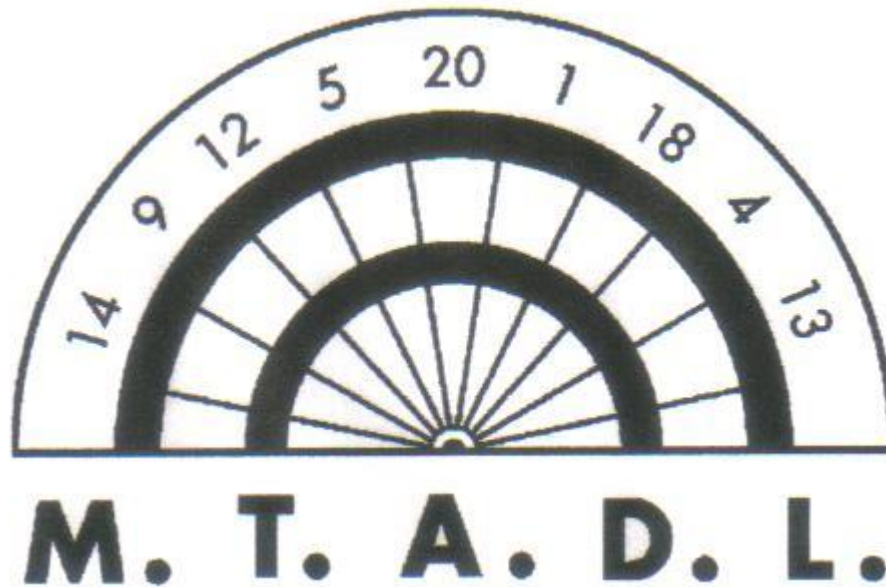

Methodology

- Assumed Fixed Location (i.e. Opponents Bar)
- Plot Desired Matchups vs. Potential Opposition
- Caveats
 - Game restrictions
 - Ignoring random factor
 - Ignoring strategy
 - Assuming no one has identical winning % (gender)

- How Can EG Help?
 - Determine 'Rank' (Singles & Doubles)
 - Create New Computed Columns
