How to write

- Coauthor or solo?
 - o Do you prefer to work alone or in a group?
 - Coauthors share the work and the royalties
 - Motivate each other
 - Coauthors get feedback early
- Outline, outline before you write
- Consistency is important
 - Capitalization, indention, spacing
- Reviewers
 - You will get negative comments
 - Look for the nugget of truth
- Finding time to write
